

We are excited for your child to join us for our Summer Preschool 2026! Please let us know how we can best support you and your child as you transition to our summer program.



**Each family is required to bring snack at least once during the summer program. Be watching for the Summer Snack Sign Up Genius to go out soon. We will be using one sign up for all the classes combined.**

**Please provide snack for a total of 30 people.**

**Bring snack one day in advance of the day it will be served.**

**This will allow us time to prep the snack for the following day!**

We do not serve anything for classroom snacks that contain nuts, traces of nuts, or which have been processed on the same equipment as nut products. Please only purchase the items and brands listed on the snack menu and check labels of items that are placed in your child's lunch to ensure they do not contain nuts. Please label sunflower butter, or soy nut butter sandwiches and home baked items so that teachers can serve them to your child.



Please be sure to slather your child with sunscreen prior to arriving at preschool each morning. In addition, please provide us with a sunscreen stick (not spray), marked with your child's name, so we can reapply before going outside in the afternoon. Our accrediting agency

(NAEYC) does not allow us to apply spray sunscreen due to inhalation concerns, and stick sunscreen makes the application process go more smoothly.

## Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures

Summer Child Care hours are 8:00 am — 4:00 pm, and we are happy to accommodate your child arriving after 8:00 and leaving before 4:00. The summer is full of fun things to do like swimming lessons and travel, and we can be flexible with arrivals and departures! Out of respect for those who are resting /napping, we ask that children not be picked up between 1:00 pm and 2:30 pm.

8:00 am drop offs will take place out on the playground, and children are welcome to bring breakfast, if they would like to. 4:00 pm pick ups will also take place on the playground.

**All children must be picked up no later than 4:00 pm. Late pickups will result in disenrollment.**

## Water Play Days!

We will be having a splashing good time on our water play days! Your child's teacher will have more information for you. Meanwhile, here are some details:

- Please have your child arrive at school wearing sunscreen (like always) and a swimsuit under play clothes.
- Please make sure your child wears water shoes or old shoes that can get wet. We ask that shoes not be backless (no flip flops) as they don't stay on children's feet.
- Please provide an extra pair of shoes and underwear for when your child changes back into his/ her play clothes.
- Please send a towel to school with your child and a bag for your child's wet clothing.
- You are welcome to send a hat and/ or sunglasses if you would like.
- **Be sure to label ALL items** (swim suit, towel, hats, etc.) so that we can accurately return those items to you.

## Illness Policy

Thank you for your help with the health and wellness of the preschool community.  
Together we make a difference!

- **Send a Brightwheel message any time your child will be absent, even if he/ she is not sick. Be sure to let us know your child's symptoms, if he or she is sick.**
- In order to return to the preschool following illness, children (and staff) must be:  
**fever free (without medication), diarrhea free, and vomiting free for 24 hours, and able to participate in the school day successfully with respect to energy level and engagement. Children with excessive amounts of mucus and coughing should remain at home to help minimize illness at the preschool.**

If your child becomes ill while at school, you will be called to pick him/ her up within 30 minutes of receiving the call. Please be sure to keep your local contact information updated with us. If we are unable to get ahold of a parent, we will continue calling down the list of emergency contacts until we reach someone.
