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- Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. A registration form and **non-refundable** \$45 fee are due at time of registration.
- Summer Camp Session 1 is May 31 June 17 and Session 2 is June 20 July 8.
- The preschool will be CLOSED on Monday, July 4th, in observance of Independence Day. On Friday, June 17 and Friday, July 8, we will close at 12:00 noon — Lunch Bunch (12-12:45 pm) and Afternoon Care (12-3 pm) will not be available.
- The two-day program is Tuesday/ Thursday; the three-day program is Monday/ Wednesday/ Friday.
- Class placement is determined by child's age, and exceptions may be made solely at the Director's discretion.
- The Intermediate Class and the Older Class are for fully potty-trained children only unless there is an identified developmental delay as documented by a healthcare professional. **Please note that our "Fully Potty-Trained" policy states: "Only children who are fully potty-trained may move up into our older classes. Fully potty-trained means that the child does not wear diapers or Pull-Ups for any portion of the school day, that there is no pattern of accidents, that both urination and bowel movements take place consistently in the toilet, and that the child is able to take care of restrooming needs independently."
- St. Luke Preschool does not accept New Mexico Department of Health Exemptions from Immunization Requirements. Children must be fully immunized, and proof of up-to-date immunizations is required to enroll.

TUITION and DROP-IN POLICIES

- Payment in full must be received prior to the first day of each session child is registered to attend.
 - Session 1 start date: May 31, 2022
 - Session 2 start date: June 20, 2022
- Failure to pay tuition will result in disenrollment unless prior arrangements have been made with the Director.
- There is a \$25.00 fee for decreasing hours. Please see the Family Handbook for details.
- There is a \$25.00 processing fee for returned checks.
- Drop-in fees: these are billed weekly following service and are due by the following Friday. Partial hours are billed at the nearest half-hourly rate.

Licensed for children ages 2-6, St. Luke Preschool is an inclusive program that welcomes all families and all children.
